

who we are

Midland County Habitat for Humanity is a faith-based nonprofit that operates as a home builder, a mortgage lender, and provider of homeowner education.



Midland County Habitat for Humanity (MCHFH) is part of a global, nonprofit housing organization operated on Christian principles that seeks to put God's love into action by building homes, communities and hope. Midland County Habitat for Humanity is dedicated to eliminating substandard housing locally and worldwide through constructing, rehabilitating and preserving homes; by advocating for fair and just housing policies; and by providing training and access to resources to help families improve their shelter conditions.

Habitat for Humanity was founded on the conviction that every man, woman and child should have a simple, durable place to live in dignity and safety, and that decent shelter in communities should be a matter of conscience and action for all.

Habitat Misconceptions

- We are a home builder and mortgage lender we do not give homes away.
- Some question if there is an affordable housing need in Midland County. In 2018 Habitat partnered with local agencies and businesses to conduct a housing study. The study reveled that Midland County has 3,200 households earning less than \$20,000 (80% live in the city), Midland lacks 1,000 units of affordable housing.
- Habitat partners with individuals and families that earn 30% to 60% of the area median income (AMI) and in some cases 80%. A family of three can earn a maximum of \$58,000 and qualify for a home with Habitat.
- Habitat builds and sells affordable housing not poverty housing. Applicants must meet income and other requirements and currently live or work in Midland County.

what are the houses like?

Habitat builds simple, decent, affordable homes.

All homes are Energy Star[®] certified and are constructed in the most efficient, cost effective and environmentally responsible methods possible.

Habitat homeowners earn between 30-60% (in some cases 80%) of the area median income and would not qualify for conventional mortgage financing. They help build their own homes alongside volunteers and complete a comprehensive homebuyer education program.

More than 70% of home construction is accomplished by community volunteers committed to help build safe places for participating families to call home.


If you have a Facebook account, click "continue using Facebook". This option will give you a greater set of peer to peer fundraising tools.

Step 4:


Verify the linked Facebook account is correct and click "continue"

Enter in your fundraising goal. You can choose the goal you would like to reach. To earn all of he Habitat swag items, you must raise \$1,000.


You can modify the message or add a personal story. If you do not have a personal story to add a default message is entered. Once your have updated, click "next".
